1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the Petroleum (Onshore) Amendment Regulation 2022.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which the *Mining and Petroleum Legislation Amendment Act 2022*, Schedule 2[1], proposed definition of *well-head* commences.

3 Amendment of Petroleum (Onshore) Regulation 2016

Clause 51A

Insert after section 51—

51A Meaning of "well-head"—the Act, s 3(1), definition of "well-head"

A well-head, of petroleum—

- (a) means the equipment installed at the surface of a well to contain pressure and provide an interface for drilling and production equipment, and
- (b) includes the following—
 - (i) the casing head,
 - (ii) a casing hanger or spool,
 - (iii) a tubing hanger,
 - (iv) flow equipment, up to and including the wing valves.
