Key activities

The NSW Resources Regulator's key activities during the quarter included:

- investigation report and animation into a dangerous incident at Attunga Limestone Mine in 2020
- media release on convictions for Macquarie Marble and Lime Pty Ltd and director Christopher Wayne Stokes for breaches of the Mining Act 1992
- penalty notices totalling \$29,500 issued in response to non-compliance with the *Mining Act* 1992 and the *Work Health and Safety (Mines and Petroleum Sites) Act* 2013
- record attendance at Electrical Engineering Safety Seminar with 270 industry representatives
- safety alerts on the failing of service brakes on a dump truck, fire suppression systems and dangers of lifting and pulling activities
- report on targeted intervention on ground or strata failure in underground coal mines
- investigation information releases regarding incidents where 3 people were injured in an ATV rollover in a quarry, a worker was seriously injured using a crowbar, a worker's leg was broken during a lifting activity, an outburst occurred during remote mining operations in a colliery, and a loader fell into a stope
- safety guidance on fires on battery powered tools, auxiliary fan operational risk assessments, a recent increase of lifting incidents, wet weather and keeping safe during the festive season
- guidance on recent changes to exploring in exempted areas and for exploring any part of the licence/lease where native title has not been extinguished
- forum held at Lightning Ridge on the enactment of Work Health and Safety (Mines and Petroleum Sites)
 Regulation 2022 which affects winding systems, and a guide for winding systems at small gemstone mines



















Rehabilitation security deposit review

Our inspectors regularly assess the surface disturbance (or proposed disturbance) of a mine or exploration site to calculate the security deposit. This is known as the assessed deposit. Once the assessed deposit is determined, we advise the area within Mining, Exploration and Geoscience responsible for title administration who vary the condition of the title and seek the additional funds-or in the case of satisfactory rehabilitation, returns some or all of the security deposit.
