## Key activities

Judgments were handed down in three proceedings before the courts for work health and safety contraventions.

Cudal Lime Products Pty Ltd was convicted and fined $\$ 900,000$ in the District Court of New South Wales on 26 February 2018 for contravention of section 31 of the Work Health and Safety Act 2011 (WHS Act). This is the first Category 1 offence conviction in NSW. A worker was also convicted and fined \$48,000 for a contravention of section 32 of the WHS Act. The convictions were in relation to a fatality near the Cudal Limestone Quarry on 27 August 2017 when a member of the public received an electric shock in a nearby cottage which received its electrical supply from the mine.

Resources Pacific Pty Ltd was found not guilty and the charges dismissed in the Supreme Court of New South Wales on 2 February 2018 for a contravention of sections 8(2) and 10(2) of the OHS Act 2000. The charges were in relation to a fatality at the Ravensworth Coal Preparation Plant on 18 February 2009 when the cabin of a haulage truck was crushed by falling material from the hopper of the reject bin.
Perilya Broken Hill Limited was found guilty in the District Court of New South Wales on 28 February 2018 for a contravention of section 32 of the WHS Act. Perilya Limited was found not guilty and the charges dismissed. The proceedings were in relation to serious injuries from a fall to the bottom of the shaft from a loader bucket while performing maintenance in the shaft at the Perilya Broken Hill Southern Operations on 8 June 2012. Perilya Broken Hill Limited will be sentenced on 13 April 2018.

The Resources Regulator accepted an enforceable undertaking from the NSW Department of Finance, Services and Innovation (DFSI) in relation to two incidents that occurred at DFSI's Heritage Stoneworks in Alexandria. The matters were referred to the regulator from SafeWork NSW, which is also part of DFSI, to avoid any real or perceived conflicts.

One incident involved the exposure of workers to hazardous crystalline silica dust levels and the other incident involved a worker suffering a fractured skull while operating a pedestrian forklift.

As part of the undertaking, DFSI have committed to a range of actions with a financial commitment of at least $\$ 498,500$. This is in addition to an estimated $\$ 500,000$ already spent on works carried out at the site following the incidents. Mine safety inspectors also responded to a coal burst event at Austar mine. The incident occurred at approximately 11pm on Friday 2 February 2018 on LWB4 longwall face, where approximately 50 tonnes of coal reported to be ejected from the face of the Hunter based operation. One worker was reported to have suffered an injury, and was transported to hospital where he received treatment for a laceration to his left hand. A section 195 notice was issued prohibiting the cutting of coal on the affected longwall until an investigation was carried out by the mine and further risk controls implemented.

In education and engagement, the roll out of the health control plan workshops continued with five workshops conducted for industry this month. Development and Implementation of a Health Control Plan is aimed at operators who are implementing a health control plan. The workshops give practical advice about how to implement, evaluate and review a health control plan. The program which commenced in October 2017 will conclude in March 2018.
