78 (2)	Appears to discount IEC 60079 certified equipment. Should allow equipment certified under this standard. Need to recognise reputable international standards instead of forcing manufacturers to have a separate set of parts for Australia from the rest of the world.
78 (5) (a)	Appears to discount plugs and receptacles certified under IEC Ex. Should allow equipment certified under this standard. Need to recognise reputable international standards instead of forcing manufacturers to have a separate set of parts for Australia from the rest of the world.
78 (6) (ii)-(iii)	These clauses are too open with regards to the supply of drawings. It is OK to require supply of drawings required to identify components, as required today. This clause does not specify this and could be utilised to obtain drawings open slather, including drawings that contain intellectual property.
