

#### Safety incidents of note



the radio mode handle from bolting mode to flit mode. The continuous miner operator has then reversed approximately one metre trapping the shuttle car driver.



An operator at an underground metalliferous mine sustained serious injury when the loader he was operating drove over the edge of a stope and fell 20 metres to the level below. The loader was a tele-remote loader which was being manually operated at the time.

#### **Education and engagement activities**

In February, the Resources Regulator published the <u>Opal Mining Compliance Priorities</u> which sets out our key compliance priorities for opal mining for 2021. The report also outlines our focus on reforms and improvement measures within the Lightning Ridge Mineral Claims District over the period including guidance material, training and the regulatory policy framework.

NSW also became first mining jurisdiction in Australia to implement an exposure standard of 0.1mg/m³ for diesel particulate matter, measured as elemental carbon, which came into force on 1 February 2021 after a 12-month transitional period. To assist industry in managing compliance with the new exposure standard, we published a Position paper: Implementation of an exposure standard for diesel particulate matter in NSW mines detailing our regulatory approach.

The revised coal dust exposure standard of 1.5mg/m<sup>3</sup> also commended on 1 February 2021.

The driver was assisting the continuous miner operator with bolting. When completed, the shuttle car driver activated the radio mode handle from bolting mode to flit mode. The continuous miner operator has then reversed approximately one metre trapping the shuttle car driver.
8 Feb	Coal mines	N/A	A worker was found on the floor of the bath house showing signs of stroke.
11 Feb	Large mines – Metalliferous and Quarries	Persons and / or object exposed to edge / drop-off	An operator sustained serious injuries when the loader that was being operated drove over the edge of a stope.
15 Feb	Coal mines	Surface vehicle interaction - Roads and Vehicle other operating areas	The drivers of a light vehicle and a haul truck had to take evasive action to avoid colliding at an intersection. The light vehicle driver stated that he did not see the truck.
16 Feb	Large mines – Metalliferous and Quarries	Loss of control of lifted load or load lifting equipment	An underground worker sustained two fractures to his leg when he was hit by a chute liner that fell to the ground when a lifting lug on the liner failed. The liner weighed about 205 kilograms.
19 Feb	Coal mines	Loss of control of lifted load or load lifting equipment	A worker who was removing a sling from a haul truck was found unconscious on the floor of the workshop.



20 Feb	Coal mines	Fire and Explosion - Surface	While being refueled on the ancillary go line fuel escaped from the tank breather of a watercart and caught fire on the machine muffler.
24 Feb	Coal mines	Surface vehicle interaction - Roads and Vehicle other operating areas	An excavator struck dozer while working.
27 Feb	Large mines – Metalliferous and Quarries	Persons exposed to energised plant	An electrician tasked with removing redundant cable cut a low voltage cable that was in service. The electrician identified a cable that he believed was redundant. The cable was tested and found to have no voltage, so the electrician proceeded to pull the cable out of its conduit. He reached a point where he could not pull any more cable through, so he cut the cable at a location further back towards the switch room. There were four conduits running together, but they crossed over where they ran behind a feeder structure, which resulted in the electrician cutting a conduit that was not the one he was removing.
